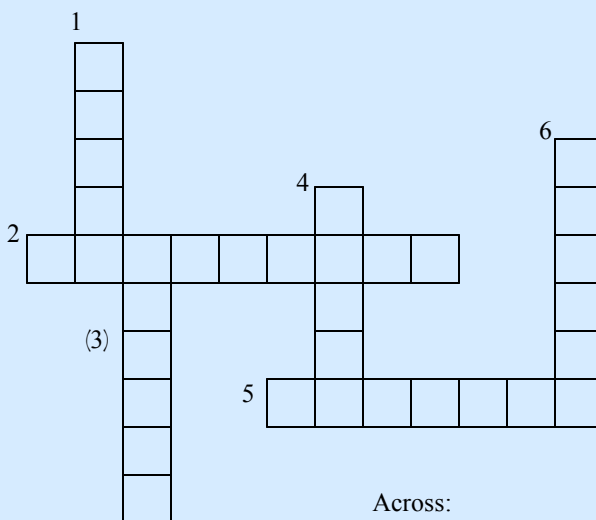
★ Verse of the Month

Our topic was on Drawing near to God and Submitting ourselves to him. What was our Verse of the Month's reference?

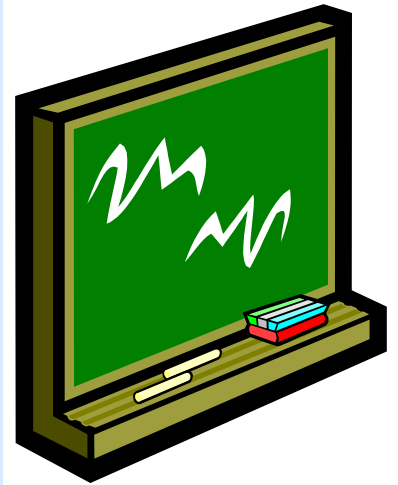
Yes! It was James 4:6-8. Sometimes the devil tempts us in even the little things, like cheating on a test or hitting or yelling at some one. God is angry when

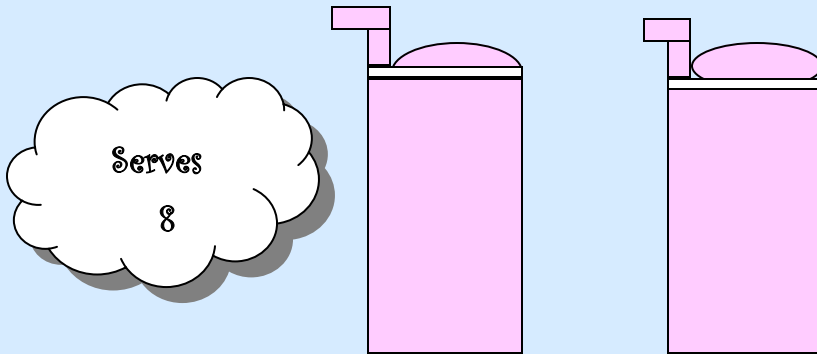
Jesus in our life. Don't push or yell; that's walking in sin.

If you like root beer floats, you'll like this too.

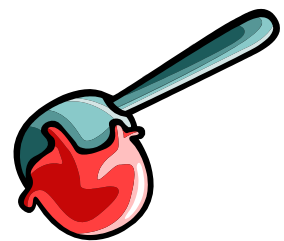


Ingredients:
