Hello! This is Grace, the author of "Girl's Mini Ministries." The newsletter topic this month is on joy. There will be a Chapter/

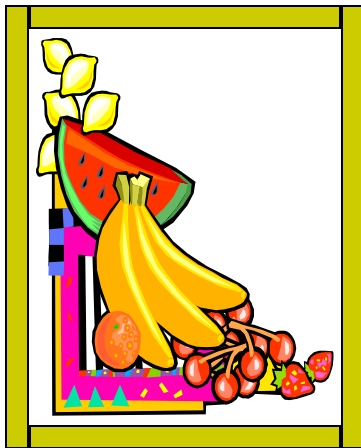

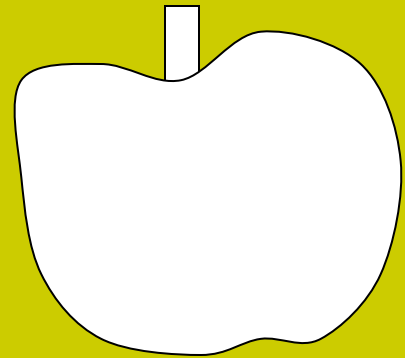
Verse of the Month

Teaching Point

We are starting a series about the fruits of the spirit. They are very important in a saved person's life.

To start off the series, we will start with joy. Here are some verses for you to look up.

- Philippians 4:4
- John 16: 20-22
- 1 Peter 1:8

I'm going to give some explanations for these verses. Phil. 4:4 talks about you rejoicing in the

Lord. John 16:20-22 says that saved people have the JOY of worshiping someone who loves you. Romans 14:7 is about heaven and having the JOY of having the Holy Spirit. 1Peter 1:8 refers to the Holy Spirit– it says “we rejoice in the Holy Spirit.” To what this all sums up to is this, when people are saved they have JOY in the Lord who is their Redeemer, God and Savior.

Now, lets talk a little about joy. Joy means: The passion or emotion excited by the acquisition or

expectation of good -1852 Webster's Dictionary

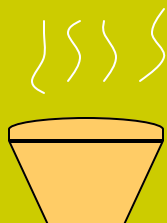
Now you may be thinking what does acquisition mean?

Cooking! Mini Apple Pies

- 1 Pillsbury pie crust (15 oz. box)
- 2 apples finely chopped
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1 tablespoon flour
- 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon vanilla

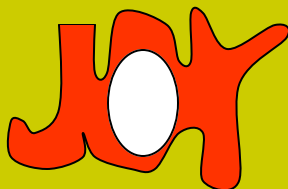


Heat the oven to 425 degrees F. Roll out the dough and cut big circles, then put it in a muffin pan. Cut the apple, and add it to a bowl with the sugar, flour, cinnamon, and vanilla. Stir, then put them in the cups. Bake for 18-30 min. Cool.



Craft A "Joyful" Frame

- Colored paper
- Glue
- Picture of someone or yourself that is okay to cut up



1. Cut out the word “joy” with scissors. 2. Glue the picture on the “o”. 3. Fold between the “j” and the “o”, repeat with the “o” and the “y”. Now you have a “joyful” frame!
