

Teaching Point

Welcome to our next Bible study on gentleness. You know, gentleness can be part of your daily life. Not fighting with a brother or sister (if you have one), or being kind to your neighbors. Gentleness is our topic for this month. Jesus uses an example of being a shepherd in a parable. It explains how he protects his "sheep" from harm. The "sheep" are people. He then also explains what a hired person would do if he saw a "wolf" coming. The hired person would flee. Jesus added that the shepherd would not flee but fight the wolf and die for his "sheep" if he had to. This teaches us that he loves all of us even though you do wrong. Jesus was an excellent example of being gentle and loving. How will you be gentle to your brothers or sisters, your parents, or your neighbors today?
