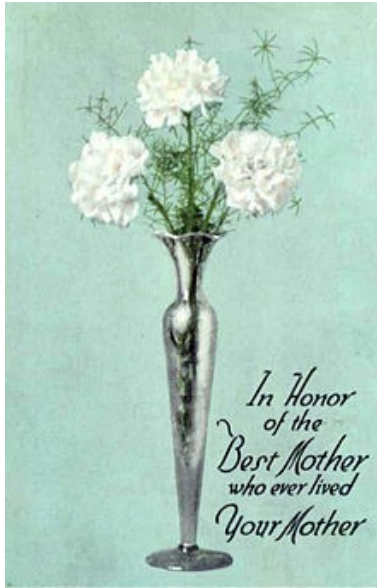


## Mother's Day

# Breakfast in Bed ONLY for Moms!

## Cinnamon-Sugar Toast

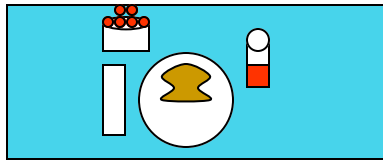
- Cinnamon
- Bread
- Sugar
- Butter

Toast the bread and spread butter on it. Mix a teaspoon of cinnamon and 2 teaspoons of sugar in a bowl until there are no packets of cinnamon left. Sprinkle on toast and put on a plate or napkin on a cookie tray.

Finishing Touches:

Put a towel on the cookie tray to make it look pretty.

Make hot chocolate if you are allowed to use the stove; if not pour some juice or milk in a glass.



## Fruit Salad

- Bananas
- Blueberries
- Strawberries
- Lemon Juice

Cut up one banana and four strawberries into bite size pieces. Put into a bowl with a 1/8 cup of blueberries. Carefully mix it together adding about 8 drops of lemon juice. Put that on the cookie tray too.

## A Mothers Day Card

First get out what you need.

- Paper (computer paper is good)
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Glitter Glue or Stickles™
- Colored Ink Pad
- Any thing else you might want to use.

Okay, so you need to fold your paper so the longest side is cut in half. Then cut on the fold so it looks like picture at the top. Take one piece of paper and fold it again the same way you did the other paper. You are going to “ink the card” by putting the ink pad face down on the front of the card like shown above. Do that all over the card. Next, you can put “Happy Mother’s Day!” on the card in pen and use your creativity with glitter glue, paper borders, sequins, gems, and more!
