- I. Genesis 1:1 "In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth."
 - i. God's existence
 - 1. Is taken for granted
 - 2. Is the greatest of mysteries
 - a. Job 11:7-9
 - b. Romans 11:36
 - 3. Unlocks thousands of other mysteries
 - ii. Cause and Effect The basis of our minds
- II. Romans 1:19-20 "Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; ... even His eternal power and Godhead;"
 - i. Man has the capacity to know there is a God
 - 1. Man is without excuse
 - 2. Creation infers a Creator Psalm 19:1-6
 - ii. Creator implies eternal power
 - 1. Create to bring into existence
 - 2. Eternal power precedes creation
 - 3. Godhead gives personality to power
 - iii. Power the ability to do something, either inherent or exercised
 - 1. Power belongs to mind or spirit not matter
 - 2. Power belongs to God
 - a. Psalm 62:11
 - b. John 19:10-11
 - 3. No intermediate step between the thought (will of the mind) and the action
 - a. Genesis 1:3
 - b. Psalm 33:8-9
 - iv. Motion is clear proof of Deity
 - 1. Implies a cause
 - 2. Implies intelligence
 - v. Mind or spirit is apart from matter
 - 1. Angels are examples

- 2. All spirits are subservient to Supreme Spirit
- 3. Opposition to Deity is absurd
 - a. Isaiah 10:15
 - b. Acts 5:39
- 4. All created beings, in this respect, are but instruments in the hand of Deity whose Will is sovereign over them.
- vi. God is the source, origin and fountain of all power
 - 1. He is the self-existent, uncaused, the First Cause
 - 2. This thought is incomprehensible
 - 3. "Eternal Power and Godhead"
 - a. I Chronicles 29:10-13
- III. Psalm 14:1 "The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God." THERE IS A GOD!!
 - i. Explain things otherwise unexplainable
 - ii. FATE that all things exist, and have existed from eternity by inevitable necessity
 - 1. Denies creation
 - 2. Unreasonable and unsatisfactory
 - iii. CHANCE the material universe was constructed out of atoms fortuitously coming together from realms unknown
 - 1. No accounting of these atoms
 - iv. Both theories exclude God from the universe
 - v. Evidences of adaptation point to intelligent design
 - 1. Gills / water; Lungs / air; Seed / Soil; Birds / air
 - 2. Intelligence and design are not properties of matter but of spirit
 - 3. The question has to arise, "Who is the Designer?"
 - 4. Hebrews 1:10-12
