 - i. Definitions:
 - 1. A person who interposes between two parties
 - 2. In a position between two individuals or parties that are in disagreement
 - a. God and man direct antagonism
 - ii. Jesus' qualification to mediate:
 - 1. Both God and man natures in one person
 - a. defend the rights of God
 - b. sympathize with human weakness
 - 2. Personal holiness
 - a. **Hebrews 7:26** Separate from sinners
 - b. necessary to mediate with God
 - c. Hebrews 4:15 like us yet without sin
 - 3. Right of self-disposal
 - a. He had the ability to voluntarily become man
 - b. Galatians 4:4-5
 - 4. Capability of death
 - a. No such nature before his incarnation
 - b. **Hebrews 9:15-17** Death was required for O.T. sins
 - iii. Do others qualify to mediate
 - 1. **Revelation 5:4-5** Only one found worthy
 - 2. I Timothy 2:5 Only one Jesus Christ
- II. Christ as Prophet
 - i. Definitions:
 - 1. Telling beforehand what should come to pass
 - 2. A messenger speaking for a monarch or king
 - a. Elijah
 - b. Moses
 - ii. A prophet prophesied

- 1. Acts 3:22 "like unto me" means "as He raised me up"
- 2. Not fulfilled by John the Baptist John 1:21
- iii. Prophecy fulfilled
 - 1. Matthew 21:10-11 Jesus, the prophet
 - 2. Fulfills definition John 1:18
 - 3. Moses & Elijah reverenced Him Mark 9:2-10
 - 4. God the Father approved of Him Matthew 17:5
 - 5. Unique among all men John 7:46

III. Christ as King

- i. Jesus is King over a Kingdom
 - 1. **John 18:36-37** King, Kingdom, Servants (of the truth)
 - 2. John 7:24 Don't be confused by appearance
 - 3. **John 10:1-5** Only his servants hear him
- ii. His Father appointed Him
 - 1. John 3:35
 - 2. Psalms 2:6
 - 3. Acts 2:36
 - 4. I Corinthians 15:24-28 Reign until He overcomes all enemies
- iii. His Kingdom
 - 1. Kingdom of Christ; Kingdom of Heaven; Kingdom of God
 - 2. Matthew 13:41 Parable of tares & wheat
 - 3. Colossians 1:13 Entrance into this kingdom
 - 4. **Daniel 2:44** Prophecy of this kingdom
 - 5. Matthew 16:18 Church kingdom ("my church')
 - 6. These are loyal subjects of the truth
 - 7. Matthew 28:19-20 Our responsibilities
 - a. ordinances in His church kingdom
 - 8. Romans 16:16 Today "churches of Christ"
 - 9. **Ephesians 5:24** Only those churches "subject to Christ"
 - 10. Jesus is our King
 - Dictating the nature of a church, its membership, its offices, its ordinances, its doctrines, its government, its discipline, and its work of evangelism
 - we are an executive democracy solemnly appointed to carry into effect the laws of Christ
