 - 1. Romans 6:1-12
 - a. baptized should not live in sin vs. 2
 - b. walk (visible) in a new life vs. 4
 - c. sin has lost its hold on us vs. 6, 7

 - a. Acts 22:16 a washing away of our sins (outward)
