## Lesson Outline

### I. Resurrection- Rising from the Dead

- i. Death
  1. Appointed unto men once to die.... – **Hebrews 9:27**
  2. All return to dust – **Ecclesiastes 12:7**
- ii. Resurrection- a miracle
  1. Some mock – **Acts 17:32**
  2. God has the power
    - a. **Matthew 28:18**
    - b. **Matthew 22:29**

### II. Resurrection - When

- i. The Interpretation of Two Resurrections
  1. Dead in Christ shall rise first – **I Thessalonians 4:13-18**
  2. "This is the first resurrection" – **Revelation 20:1-6**
    - a. souls beheaded for the witness of Jesus
    - b. souls not bodies, therefore, not a physical resurrection
- ii. Simultaneous Resurrection of Righteous and Wicked
  1. All will hear in that hour – **John 5:28-29**
  2. A resurrection of both just and unjust – **Acts 24:15**
- iii. The Order of Events
  1. The Lord Jesus will return in glory with His angels – **Matthew 25:31**
  2. A shout, voice of archangel, trumpet of God – **I Thessalonians 4:16**
  3. Sainted dead raised and saved changed – **I Corinthians 15:52**
  4. Unsaved raised to shame and everlasting contempt – **Daniel 12:2**

### III. Resurrection Body - Saved

- i. Raised in Incorruption
  1. Sown in corruption – **I Corinthians 15:42**
  2. Incorruption is immortality – **Luke 20:36**

- ii. Raised in Glory
  - 1. Fashioned like Christ's glorious body – **Philippians 3:21**
  - 2. Righteous will shine – **Matthew 13:43**
- iii. Raised in Power
  - 1. This is contrasted to being sown in weakness – **I Corinthians 15:43**
- iv. Spiritual Bodies – **I Corinthians 15:44-50**
