    - 1. Acts 5:3-4 lying to the Holy Spirit is the same as lying to God

    - 3. **I Corinthians 6:19** our body is the temple of the Holy Ghost
  - ii. Divine perfections are ascribed to the Holy Spirit
    - 1. **Hebrews 9:14** "eternal Spirit"
    - 2. I Corinthians 2:10 "for the Spirit searcheth all things"
    - 3. Psalms 139:7 Spirit is omnipresent
