- I. Creation- Why? And What?
 - i. Why Creation?
 - 1. creation initiates the execution of God's divine purposes
 - 2. His plan required creation
 - 3. it is worthy of God to do "all things after the counsel of His own will"
 - ii. What is creation?
 - 1. the production of something out of nothing
 - 2. the axiom, "out of nothing, nothing comes:, is good for men but not for God
 - 3. this idea of absolute origin is the central idea in creation
- II. Understanding Creation
 - i. The bible is the only authoritative reference material
 - 1. since only God was present at creation
 - 2. no other historical text goes back to creation
 - ii. Faith must replace sight to fully grasp this subject
 - 1. **Hebrews 11:3**
 - a. things seen were not made of things which do appear
 - iii. believe the testimony recorded in Genesis
 - 1. Psalms 33:6, 9
- III. The Events of Creation
 - i. Genesis 1:1-5 -- 1st Day
 - 1. created Heaven and Earth
 - 2. without form, void, and darkness
 - 3. Spirit of God moved (hovered or brooded) upon the face of waters
 - 4. light first created then separated from darkness
 - 5. marking of time
 - ii. Genesis 1:6-8 2nd Day
 - 1. a firmament to divide the waters
 - a. <u>firmament</u> vault or arch of the sky, the heavens
 - 2. **Genesis 7:11** -- water below and above Heaven

- iii. **Genesis 1:9-13** 3rd Day
 - 1. gathering together of waters under the heavens in one place
 - 2. **Genesis 10:25** -- appearing of dry land Earth (in one place)
 - 3. grass, herbs, trees seed after it's own kind
- iv. **Genesis 1:14-19** 4th Day
 - 1. lights in the firmament of the heaven
 - a. sun greater light to rule the day
 - b. moon lesser light to rule the night
 - c. stars ornaments
 - 2. to divide the day from the night
 - 3. for signs, seasons, days and years
 - 4. to give light upon the earth
- v. **Genesis 1:20-23** 5th Day
 - 1. sea life abundantly
 - 2. fowl to fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven
 - 3. reproduced after their own kind
 - 4. fish and fowl came forth from the substance of the waters
- vi. **Genesis 1:24-31** 6th Day
 - 1. living creature
 - a. cattle domestic animals
 - b. creeping things reptiles
 - c. beast of the earth wild animals
 - 2. reproduced after it's own kind
 - 3. man created in God's image after His likeness
 - a. with dominion over all the earth
 - b. male and female
 - 4. God blessed man and charged him:
 - a. to be fruitful, multiply, replenish & subdue the earth
 - b. to have dominion over every thing on the earth
 - 5. **Ecclesiastes 7:29** -- God made man upright, (righteous)
 - 6. Ephesians 4:24 & Colossians 3:10 salvation restores a fallen man to righteousness
 - 7. "God saw every thing he had made and, behold, it was very good."
- IV. Reflections on Creation
 - i. completed in 6 days
 - 1. **Genesis 2:1-2** God rested on the 7th day
 - 2. Exodus 20:11 "for in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is,:

- ii. Literal days, not figurative
 - 1. evening and morning marked the time
 - 2. Moses was moved by God to write for contemporary times
- iii. God's purpose in creation
 - 1. Revelation 4:11 for God's pleasure, i.e. His will
 - 2. Proverbs 16:4 for Himself
 - 3. **Isaiah 42:8** for His own glory
 - 4. Colossians 1:16 all thing created by Him, and for Him
- iv. Our reaction
 - 1. **Revelations 15:3-4** "Great and marvelous are thy works, Lord God Almighty."
